Director's Report August 2022

In August I attended regular meetings with the City Council and the Friends of the Library. I provided a written library report for the Solon Public Library Foundation meeting in August as I was not able to attend in person. I also had the privilege of attending the 3-day ILA Leadership Institute at the beginning of the month. I am so grateful for the opportunity to learn from leadership expert Maureen Sullivan and 25 other library professionals from all over the state.

Our weekly volunteers logged over 105 hours this summer providing valuable assistance with multiple activities. We are so grateful to the 10 teens and 5 adults who assisted in multiple ways throughout the summer. We could not have accomplished our Summer Reading Program plans without them! We wish our teen volunteers the best as they begin their new school year. We look forward to continuing to work with our adult volunteers and plan to provide fall orientation sessions for new teens who wish to volunteer.

Our Summer Reading Program (SRP) ended on Saturday, August 20 and patrons were still turning in slips right up until we closed. The grand prize winners have been notified. Be sure to watch for pictures of our happy winners on our social media posts. We handed out over 400 t-shirts provided by Hills Bank, 700 baseball tickets provided by the Iowa Cubs, and thousands of small prizes to eager readers and program participants of all ages all summer long. Our Dinosaurs at Dusk program with Jack Neuzil attracted dinosaur lovers of all ages and made the front page of the Solon Economist. What a privilege to work with Jack and Krishna Bharadwaj on this family program. Thank you to everyone who stayed to help us put away all of the dinosaurs. You will see that one large dinosaur friend is hanging out on our front porch after a fresh coat of polyurethane. They just didn't want to go back in the basement!
