This library program is offered as a service to our community, it is a drop-in program, no registration.

Supervision is provided during the Library program in the meeting room. All children in 1st-3rd grades MUST attend the program, and be picked up by a caregiver at 2:45 PM. Older children may enjoy the program or the rest of the Library. There is no adult supervision outdoors at any time. We recommend parents and caregivers discuss these expectations, pick-up plans, etc. with their children. Library staff are sharing these programs for participating children but this does not provide the need for supervised childcare. Mark your calendars and join us in September for BAM POW!

Unattended Child Policy

The Solon Public Library staff welcomes children to use our services and facilities and we provide adult supervision during Thursday Early Out programs (1:45-2:45 PM) and during other special programming as advertised. Outside of scheduled programs, children under age 10 must be accompanied by a designated caregiver at least 11 years old.

There is no adult supervision outdoors at any time except during outdoor programming as advertised.

Switch & Social begins in September!

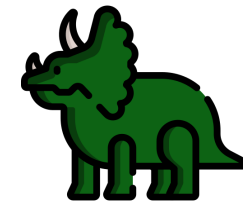
Teens in 6th-12th grades can enjoy snacks, games, and friends on Tuesdays after school, 3:30-4:30 PM.

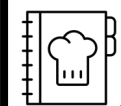

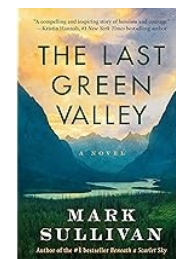
DIY Night: Tues, August 13th @ 6:30 PM
